## WINE FOR THE 41<sup>ST</sup> INVESTITURE DINNER OF THE GRAN ORDEN DE CABALLEROS DEL VINO 4th June 2026

Dear friends & colleagues,

We are delighted to announce that the 41<sup>st</sup> Investiture Dinner of the Gran Orden de Caballeros del Vino will take place on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2026**, at The Landmark London Hotel.

Since its establishment in 1984, the Gran Orden has recognised exceptional contributions from members of the wine trade who have gone above and beyond the call of duty in their promotion of Spanish wines. The Gran Orden is currently made up of 71 wine professionals across the spectrum, from winemakers and winery owners in Spain to wine importers and retailers in the UK, as well as chefs, restaurateurs, journalists, educators and many more besides.

The Investiture Dinner is an annual event that celebrates the excellence of Spanish wines in the UK, bringing together over 250 key figures in the trade to officially welcome the new Caballeros to the Gran Orden. The bespoke dinner menu will be designed and thoughtfully paired to highlight the wines selected specifically for the event by a panel of Gran Orden members. This makes the dinner an ideal opportunity to showcase outstanding Spanish wines to some of the most influential people in the trade.

We are now inviting UK Spanish wine importers to submit entries to the tasting for this year's dinner. Details of the different styles and quantities are as follows:

- Two bottles of each wine must be sent for the wine tasting (delivery details to follow).
- An additional two bottles of selected wines will then be required for the menu tasting.
- The following quantities of wine will be needed for the dinner as per each style:

TO MATCH	STYLE OF WINE	REQUIRED QUANTITY (approx. nº of bottles)
Investiture	Sherry / Montilla / Rosado (1 brand)	48 bottles
Starter	White wine (max. 2 brands)	72 bottles
Main Course	Red wine (max. 2 brands)	78 bottles
Dessert	Unfortified Sweet / Sherry / Montilla (1 brand)	66 bottles
No / Low	Sparkling, white or red (1 brand)	up to 24 bottles

*\* In addition to the above, DO Cava de Guarda Superior wines will be served during the reception and stirrup-cup. Please refer to the separate letter outlining details.*

Successful wine sponsors will receive:

- Branding at the event
- Tasting note and company details in the event programme
- Discounted tickets to the Dinner: equivalent to 25% of the total value of the wines at 12
