## 2. Descripción y evolución de la Feria

Los días 7, 8 y 9 de junio de 2023, se celebró la quinta edición de la feria Ghana Mining & Energy Summit de manera presencial en el *Accra International Conference Centre* de la capital del país.

La feria tenía como propuesta principal “Aprovechar el potencial minero y energético para el desarrollo nacional sostenible”. Siguiendo esta línea, las tecnologías y soluciones presentadas buscaban, sobre todo, ayudar a mejorar la producción y potenciar la productividad del sector, debido a las oportunidades mineras y energéticas que existen en el país.

Esta feria es un evento conjunto en el que además se llevaron a cabo unas conferencias enfocadas en el mismo sector representados tanto por expertos nacionales como internacionales, en las cuales se abordaron las necesidades de la industria local de la minería y la energía.

La feria fue inaugurada por el ministro de Tierras y Recursos Naturales, Samuel A. Jinapor y el ministro de Energía, Matthew Opoku Prempeh, junto al CEO de la Ghana Chamber of Mines, Sulemanu Koney. Tras la inauguración, los ministros y el resto de altos cargos dieron un discurso en el salón de conferencias, fueron visitando los diferentes *stands* de la feria y se pararon a conversar con muchas de las empresas, poniendo especial interés en las ghanesas.

Asimismo, Eric Asubonteng, expresidente de la Cámara de Minas de Ghana y director general de AngloGold Ashanti Ghana, realizó una presentación sobre las operaciones de la empresa en Ghana. En 2022, las minas Obuasi e Iduapriem de AngloGold pagaron 140,4 millones de dólares en impuestos al gobierno de Ghana. Después de él, Celestina Allotey, vicepresidenta de Gold Fields, compartió los aspectos más destacados de sus operaciones en el país. La sesión inaugural terminó con las palabras de los patrocinadores principales, Mukesh V. Thakwani, CEO de B5 Plus y Lenn Kolff, Director Comercial de Atlantic Lithium.

## 2.1. Organización de la feria

La feria tuvo lugar en el *Accra International Conference Centre* considerado el principal centro de conferencias más importante de Ghana y en el que se celebran la gran mayoría de ferias y eventos en Accra. Dispone de seis salas con una capacidad total de 6.000 personas; la sala más grande tiene capacidad para 1.600 personas. Los *stands* se distribuyeron ocupando la zona central del recinto y, en la sala de conferencias, se realizaron cada día jornadas de diferentes temáticas desde las 9 de la mañana hasta las 17 de la tarde.

Este salón de conferencias se situaba la parte derecha de la entrada al recinto, y fue el lugar donde se realizaron conferencias previstas del Ghana Mining & Energy Summit 2023, un programa de gran calibre enfocado en las necesidades de las industrias de la minería y energía locales, que estuvo representado por expertos nacionales e internacionales.

En la planta superior, se realizaban cada día los almuerzos y pausas entre jornadas. En ella, los invitados a la feria podían conocer a otros empresarios de su mismo sector o adentrarse en el *networking* con futuros clientes.

Finalmente, esta feria no tuvo participación de empresas españolas.

PLANO DEL GHANA MINING & ENERGY SUMMIT 2023





## 2.2. Expositores y asistentes

A la feria acudieron 33 expositores (ver Anexo 5.1. para listado completo). Sin lugar a duda, la feria estuvo dominada por la presencia de empresas ghanesas. Sus *stands* ocuparon un 40 % con bastante distancia con sus seguidores, Sudáfrica, con un 12% del espacio total del evento. El resto de los *stands* se repartieron entre EE. UU. (que contó con 3 empresas), Australia, Francia, Canadá y Suiza (que contaron con 2 empresas cada uno) y, Alemania (con la Delegación de Industria y Comercio alemana en Ghana), Israel, Filipinas, Senegal y Bélgica que asistieron con una sola empresa.

### DISTRIBUCIÓN POR NACIONALIDAD DE LOS EXPOSITORES



### 3. Tendencias y novedades presentadas

Esta feria, que se celebra cada dos años en el país (la última vez que se celebró fue en 2019 ya que, en 2021, el COVID lo impidió), ha servido como plataforma para que los empresarios del sector minero y energético expusieran sus últimas novedades y mostraran las tendencias actuales y las que se seguirán en el futuro. A continuación, se recoge un breve resumen de la tipología de empresas que participaron en el evento:

- **Empresas mineras**
- **Proveedores del sector minero**
- **Proveedores del sector energético**
- **Profesionales de diversas industrias**
- **Funcionarios públicos**

El Ghana Mining & Energy Summit es un evento que, aunque es internacional, se enfoca más en la región de Ghana. Por el contrario, [WAMPEX](#) (la exposición de minería y energía de África Occidental) que se celebrará el año que viene y que ya cuenta con 17 ediciones, incluye a más de 2.000 responsables de la toma de decisiones de toda África Occidental y, también se realiza cada dos años en el país.





## 4. Valoración

### 4.1. Del evento en su conjunto

En general, la feria contó con una buena organización tanto previa como durante el evento. Ofrece a los principales agentes del sector de los recursos, incluidos inversores, mineros, reguladores y empresas de servicios, la oportunidad de reunirse en un mismo espacio y promover oportunidades y aprendizajes.

Asimismo, fue un buen espacio para descubrir nuevos contactos, tanto a homólogos como a posibles clientes o inversores. Partiendo de la base de que Ghana es el principal productor de oro de África, este evento pretendió promover la huella del sector de recursos ghanés en toda África y facilitar debates que apoyen el aumento de oportunidades.

Aunque no se conocen los datos exactos de participación, la estimación previa de más de 1.000 visitantes hecha por la empresa organizadora parece razonable. De la misma forma, el número original de 33 expositores fue el definitivo.

Ha sido destacada la participación de las empresas ghanesas en esta feria, debido al interés del sector minero en el tejido empresarial ghanés. Según las conversaciones mantenidas con agentes del sector presentes en el evento, tanto las empresas expositoras como los visitantes mostraron entusiasmo respecto al resultado del evento que, después de tres años sin celebrarse por la pandemia, volvió a tener lugar. Esto se debe principalmente a dos hitos:

- Ghana es el mayor productor de oro de África; superó a Sudáfrica en 2019 con una producción de 4,8 millones de onzas. El oro es el mineral más explotado comercialmente en Ghana, y representa alrededor del 95 % de los ingresos minerales del país.
- Desde 2007, Ghana se ha convertido en un exportador de energía a sus países vecinos como Togo y Burkina Faso, así como también, desde 2011, es exportadora de petróleo crudo y gas natural, y también es capaz de generar electricidad mediante energía térmica, hidroeléctrica, solar y energías renovables desde 2012.

### 4.2. De la participación española y países competidores

No acudieron participantes de España, y, de países europeos, únicamente se verificó la participación de varias empresas provenientes de Francia, Suiza, Alemania y Bélgica.



### 4.3. Recomendaciones

Desde la primera edición en 2013, esta feria ha servido de escaparate para los agentes del sector energético y minero del país. Su crecimiento ha sido exponencial y atrae a participantes del sector de todo el mundo.

Como economía emergente que trata de acelerar el crecimiento y garantizar el desarrollo sostenible, Ghana no tiene más remedio que adoptar nuevas tecnologías y prácticas del resto del mundo para complementar las soluciones locales y poder así transformar su economía. Por ello, 'Mining & Energy Summit' es una plataforma que sirve para conocer las novedades del sector, pero también las carencias, y es aquí donde pueden surgir las oportunidades de negocio para las empresas españolas.

La valoración general de la feria es positiva, pero lo cierto es que, la inversión a realizar es elevada y sería conveniente para la empresa acudir en modalidad de visitante previamente para poder evaluar si la empresa española encaja con el perfil del resto de expositores, conocer el perfil de los visitantes, así como la organización del evento y las características y distribución del espacio ofrecido.

Dicho esto, si se decide participar, se recomienda lo siguiente:

- Se debería organizar la participación con antelación suficiente. Es importante llegar unos días antes de la feria para supervisar que todo el material encargado funciona correctamente.
- Si las características del negocio lo permiten, se recomienda encarecidamente traer muestras a la feria, pues al operador ghanés le gusta tocar y ver la mercancía *in situ* antes de comprarla.
- De la misma forma, se recomienda ofrecer folletos, catálogos y tarjetas de contacto traducidos al inglés. La página web de la empresa española también debería estar correctamente traducida.
- En el caso de que la persona representante de la empresa no hable inglés, será necesario contratar un intérprete.
- Con anterioridad o posterioridad a la feria, es recomendable organizar una agenda de visitas con potenciales clientes para aprovechar al máximo la estancia en Ghana.
- Si se desea establecer y/o mantener el contacto con alguna empresa local, se debe tener en cuenta que muchos de los correos serán no corporativos y en la gran mayoría de casos las empresas no cuentan con una página web. Además, es muy común que los ghaneses no respondan al correo electrónico, por ello es mejor usar el teléfono como medio de comunicación. Por último, se recomienda insistir con las llamadas telefónicas y, de haber agendado una reunión (presencial o virtual), será necesario confirmar con antelación (incluso el mismo día) la asistencia del contacto ghanés.
