

Security

The Organizer will engage a security agency to ensure the general security and safety in the exhibition hall. Nevertheless, responsibility is expressly denied for any loss or damage that may befall any person or property of the exhibitor from any cause whatsoever. Exhibitors must arrange their own insurance to cover all stage of the Exhibition.

Exhibitors are advised to:

- a) Bring in and display small portable and valuable exhibits/ display items nearer to Exhibition opening day and store them securely after exhibition closes each day.
- b) To hire security personnel to attend exclusively to your stand for the exhibition if your exhibits/ displays are very valuable or sensitive.
- c) Pack all exhibits and display immediately after exhibition closes on **18 June 2025**.
- d) Do not leave the stand unattended during exhibition hours and when exhibition closed on 18 June. We strongly recommend at least one representative from the stand to supervise all dismantling, packing and collection of exhibits/ displays until a complete hand-over to the nominated agent/ forwarder is done. None of the exhibitors are allowed to stay in the exhibition hall outside the official opening hours unless written approval has been given by the Organizer.

Smoking Policy

In compliance with the Smoking (Prohibition in Certain Places) Act (Cap. 310), smoking of tobacco products, E-cigarette is strictly prohibited in all areas within the entire Convention and Exhibition Centre at time. This non-smoking ban also includes non-air-conditioned areas such as car parks, staircases, loading bays, toilets and areas within the six (6) meters radius from the Centre's outer perimeters.

Statutory Requirements

Notwithstanding any other provisions in this Exhibitor Manual, The Exhibitor shall be responsible for compliance of all local authority requirement, legal obligations, and codes of practice, where applicable, in advertising materials for use at the exhibition.

Exhibitors shall indemnify the Organizer for any claims, cost, expenses, liabilities, and damages that the Organizer may incur or suffer due to any breach of this obligation.
